



Assisting Electric Consumers with Community Solar Subscription

With Community Solar USA - Electric customers can subscribe to available Community Solar projects for no cost to get a portion of the benefits.

No construction, space or capital – Third party developers own the system on off-site property in the region and you get savings.

What is Community Solar?

The U.S. Department of Energy defines community solar as a solar project within a geographic area in which the benefits flow to multiple customers such as businesses, nonprofits, individuals and other groups.

After enrollment in a project a portion of the energy generated by the community solar project is allocated to customer's accounts and the customers receive electric bill credits for electricity generated by their portion of the community solar system.

Community solar can be a great option for businesses or people who prefer not to install solar panels on their roofs or be responsible for the solar system or it's costs.

Subscribing to a community solar project does not change your electric supplier.

Community solar is rapidly growing across the country.

How Does Community Solar Work?

Community solar projects generate electricity from sunlight and the electricity flows through a meter to the utility grid. With Community Solar USA - community solar subscribers (i.e., businesses, households or other electricity customer) receive billing credits on their electric bill for electricity generated by the community solar project.

The local utility pays the community solar provider for the energy generated and each subscriber receives a portion of the dollar value generated by their community solar subscription as a credit. This credit in some utilities is applied directly to a subscriber's monthly electric bill, helping to reduce customers' electricity costs.

Billing Credits

Community solar subscribers can generally get either a discount on their electric bill for the billing credits provided by the community solar project or get a discount on the billing credits provided depending on the rules and availability in their area.

Why Community Solar?

Community solar can allow all eligible business and house-holds and businesses to access the benefits of solar energy, such as lower electricity costs, regardless of whether they're able to host a system on their own roof. In addition to savings, other benefits of community solar include community wealth building, and local job creation.
